## THE MAP OF MY HEART



### MATERIALS

- Bisque: Medium Heart Plate
  - Pen
  - Medium Flat Brush
  - Small Round Brush
- Paint: 29, 62, 98, 3, 19, 55, 101, 69, 67

### TIPS

- Before starting this project, think of 8 things that you love the most.
- Make a plan on a piece of paper and then copy it onto the heart plate.
- Dip the back of the brush into underglaze and touch the piece with it to make dots.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Divide the heart plate in eight sections. Copy the sections from the sample image or create your own variation. Use a pen to mark the lines that separate the sections. It is a good idea to sketch it out on a piece of paper first.
2. Paint each section with one of the background colors. Apply 3 coats, allowing the underglaze to dry between the coats. Use a medium flat brush to carefully fill each individual section with its color. Wash the brush well between the colors, or use multiple brushes.
3. Once all eight sections are colored in, add white dots between each section. Use a small round brush. Dip the back of the handle into white underglaze, # 67 to make each dot.

Note: Once the plate is finished (glazed and fired), use a dry-erase, or a wet-erase marker to write inside of each section. This will represent the map of your heart - the things you love the most.
