Pen

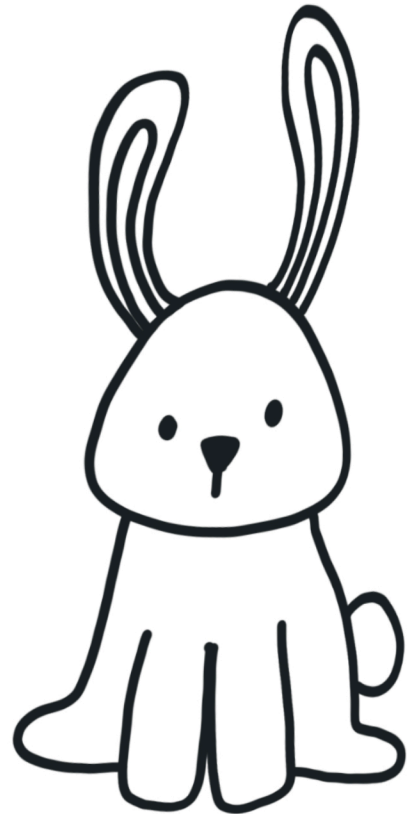
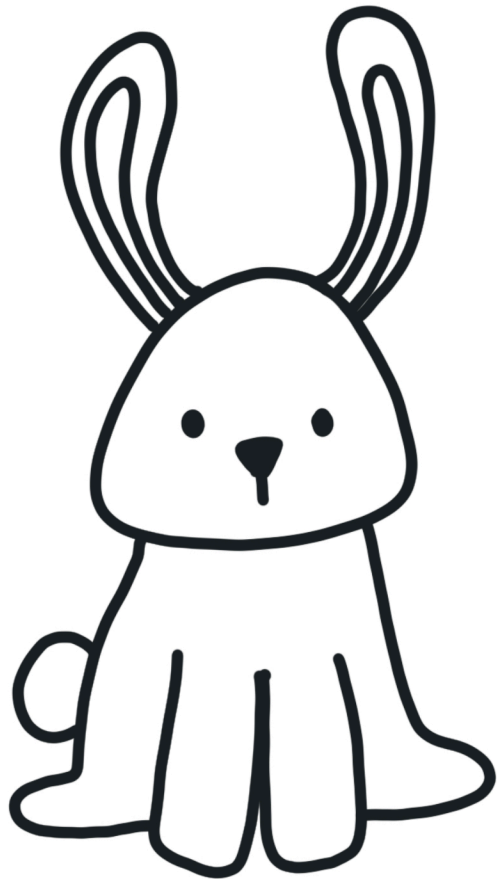
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use a detail brush to fill in both bunny's tails with 3 coats of Snowflake.
2. Next, fill in the inside section of the ears with 3 coats of Carnation using a detail brush.
3. Fill in one bunny with 3 coats of Gum Drop. Fill in the outer part of the ear, the head, and the body.
4. Fill in the other bunny with 3 coats of Chiffon. Fill in the outer part of the ear, the head, and the body.
5. Use a detail brush to paint in the highlighted words with 2 coats of Coral Reef.
6. Fill in the rest of the lettering with one heavy coat of Passionate Plum.
7. Water down Licorice with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to create a messy double outline around each bunny. This is supposed to look whimsical and not perfect.
8. Use a detail brush to apply the eyes and nose on each bunny.
9. Finally use a detail brush to apply little hearts to the background with a heavy coat of Fresh Heather. To make the hearts easy, just do a letter "v".

TIPS

- Using a heavy coat of Fresh Heather for the hearts will make a subtle pattern on the water color background.
- The harder to press on your brush, the heavier the line will be.
